


For the "12th plan-project" in Cologne, this room in a hall of the DQE was designed for lectures and workshops. The freely suspended wooden laths and fluorescent lamps combine into a translucent curtain floating above the white rectangular carpet. The roughly cut wood, white carpet, and clear neon light contrast with the existing structure and the traces of the automotive workshop, creating a new layer for the theme of the architecture biennale exhibition "Scenario of a city worth living in".
